With very different approaches to creating art, the two artists decided to come together to showcase their latest collections, shaped by their international backgrounds and personal journeys over the last decade. 'Progress', the title of the exhibition, is prominent in both artists' series of artworks as Karine Gullino discusses a historic social progress throughout the Viking Era, and Sebastian May reflects on recent social progress made in environmental and wildlife protection.

**Karine Gullino** exhibits a series of delicate embroideries, bronze works, and painting, using traditional techniques that have been used by Nordic cultures throughout the ages. Central to her research stands an exploration of the Viking Era, and more specifically the misrepresentation of an era, historic events, and its people.
